

Resource provides free gently-used clothing for younger children (ages O-12) who are currently in foster care or were in foster care and now live with their adoptive/guardianship family. You must bring proof of your foster/adoptive status (for example, a current Children's Division check stub).

This program is ONLY offered to children currently
