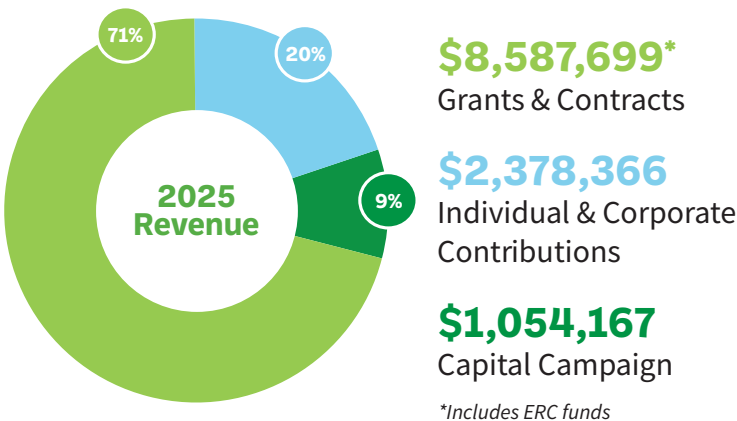
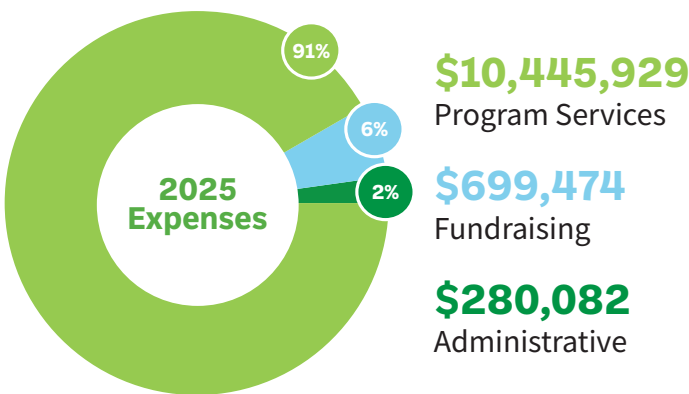

Finding Homes for Children

348 children served

Respite Care

1,914 hours of respite care provided, a nearly 19% increase from 2024

Family Support

105 new foster caregivers, including kinship & treatment foster families

1,623 youth and caregivers served,* a 17% increase from 2024

96% of placements remained stable

* Support programs including the Coalition CareLine, Educational Advocacy, Comprehensive Systems Navigation, and Older Youth Readiness.

Training Programs

658 caregivers trained

1,166 child welfare professionals trained, a 200% increase from 2024

Material Supports

8,289 children served
